


“Mocking Jesus”

¹² “What shall I do, then, with the one you call the king of the Jews?” Pilate asked them.


¹³ “Crucify him!” they shouted. ¹⁴ “Why? What crime has he committed?” asked Pilate. But they shouted all the louder, “Crucify him!” ¹⁵ Wanting to satisfy the crowd, Pilate released Barabbas to them. He had Jesus flogged, and handed him over to be crucified.



Falling on their knees, they paid homage to him. ²⁰ And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple robe and put his own clothes on him. 


“Mocking Jesus”

¹ After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven... ² At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it.




- ¹ Then Pilate took Jesus and had him flogged.
- ² The soldiers twisted together a crown of thorns and put it on his head. They clothed him in a purple robe ³ and went up to him again and again, saying, “Hail, king of the Jews!” And they struck him in the face. ⁴ Once more Pilate came out and said to the Jews, “Look, I am bringing him out to you to let you know that I find no basis for a charge against him.”
- ⁵ When Jesus came out wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe, Pilate said to them, “Here is the man!” **John 19:1-5**

9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.





They put a staff in his right hand and knelt in front of him and mocked him. “Hail, king of the Jews!” they said. ³⁰ They spit on him, and took the staff and struck him on the head again and again. ³¹ After they had mocked him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him away to crucify him.



“They claimed to know God, but by their actions they denied Him.”



¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.




41 In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him.

44 In the same way the robbers who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him.


