**Message from Holly Diebel:** "My dad is hanging in there and is trying to keep his spirits up but he is pretty miserable physically. He has been battling fluid overload so his abdomen and legs are very swollen, he gets tired and out of breath because of this too. It's hard for him to sleep so he can only nap for an hour or two, he is cold all the time (I got him a heated blanket for Christmas), and he is so itchy/dry and if he scratches too much he bleeds a lot because of the blood thinners. He's a mess :) But they did get approved for a different insurance plan and will be able to continue with all of the pre-transplant tests that need to be done to put him on the list and will determine how high on the list he will be. We really appreciate prayers and support, it's been so hard for him and really draining on us." **She requests** a continual prayer request for her dad and family regarding his health? The insurance is good news and a praise as before the insurance was not going to approve a transplant. So please remember in prayer Jeff and Holly Diebel who worshipped with us until this past year, and her dad who had a massive heart attack and needs a new heart, and family.
