SATAN'S LIE

You are a sinner because you sometimes sin.

You get your identity from what you have done.

Your behavior tells you what to believe about yourself.

GOD'S TRUTH

You are a saint, one declared righteous by God, who sometimes sins! (1 Cor. 1:2; Phil. 1:1; Col. 3:1; 1 Pet. 1:1-4; 2:9)

You get your identity from what God has done for you. (Eph. 1:7; 2 Cor. 5:17; Gal.2:20)

You get your identity from what God says about you "in Him." (Rom. 6; Eph 1:2-6)

God says: 1. The blood of Jesus applies to my record. I'm safe. (Ex. 12) 2. My guilt is cleansed. (Heb. 9:11-14; 10:19-22) 3. The devil can't separate me from God's love and care. (Rom. 8:1, 34-39)

Your belief about yourself determines your behavior. (John 14:6-12; John 15)

A person practices what he believes in times of crisis, not what he professes; belief therefore determines conduct.

- ◆ Know what God says about my position in Christ.
- ◆ Believe it to be true; this is who I am.
- ◆ As a result I will act in Christ-like ways.
- ◆ Submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you. (James 4:7)
