Lord's Day 1

Question & Answer 1

Q. What is your only comfort in life and in death?

A. That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul,
in life and in death—to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ.
(1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 2 Corinthians 5:15)

He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil.

(1 Peter 1:18-19; Heb. 2:14-15; Job 1:6-22, 2:1-10)

He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

(Matthew 10:29-31; Job 42:1-6; Jeremiah 29:11-14a; Luke 13:1-5)

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit,

assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.

(1 John 4:13-16, 5:11-15)
